Every team in the 2006 World Diamond Source Billfish Challenge had a strategic decision to make. Which inlet do we check out of? Teams can choose from 3 different inlets starting with Government Cut in Miami, moving up the coast to Hillsboro Inlet in Pompano Beach, and a northern checkpoint at Lakeworth Inlet in West Palm. "This is a signature feature of our tournament," said Jamie Bunn, director of the Billfish Challenge. "It opens the event up to a larger field of teams and provides the competitors with more options. Figure out where you think the bite is going to be the best and choose your inlet accordingly."



There's also a prize category in the tournament that awards a hefty payout to the top team from each inlet. Some teams may choose their inlet based on the bite and others will choose it based on the level of competition out of each inlet. Again, it's all about strategy. The tournament committee could make a small fortune at the kickoff party by selling the checkout information for each team. But don't worry guys... your secret is safe with the committee.

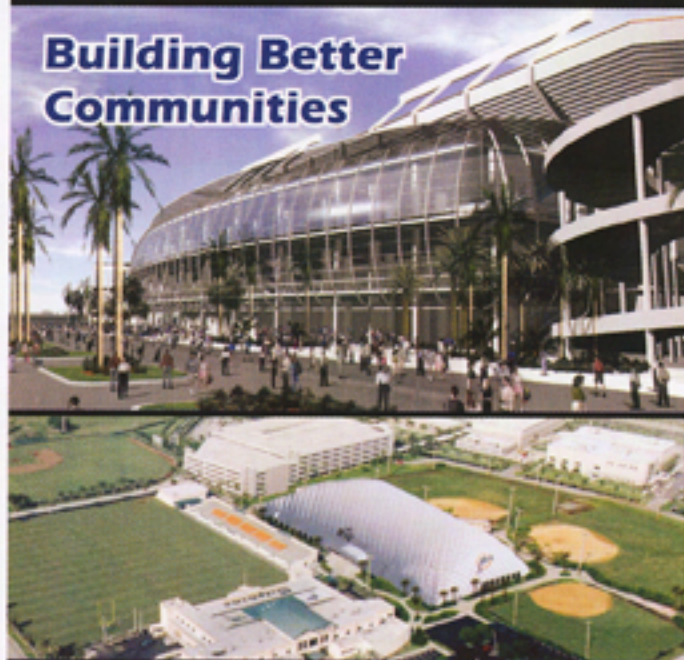
